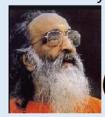

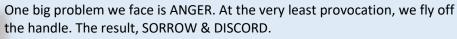

Anger is a state of the mind. It expresses as irritability, as full-blown explosive dramatics. To stay calm in every situation, we need to examine the very genesis of Anger.

Anger arises from attachment. From attachments rise expectations. Non-fulfilment of desires causes disappointment. Failure to manage disappointment. The obstacle to our ambition becomes a target for ANGER! Relationships  $\Rightarrow$  Expectations  $\Rightarrow$  Insistence  $\Rightarrow$  ANGER!
